

## FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) – GT Cumbre World Championship

- **“¿Can I participate using a controller instead of a complete sim-rig?”**

Yes, from our part we don't recommend participation because of control lack when using a controller in Assetto Corsa. It's not optimal to compete properly.

- **“¿What cars and tracks are we using in the races?”**

Every race has different track-car combination; every participant is going to use the exactly same model and fixed setup for maximum equality. The following sections are the different combinations that are going to be celebrated for each race:

- 1: Porsche GT3 Cup 991.2 (2017) – Nurbürgring Nordschleife
- 2: Lotus Emira GT4 – Zandvoort
- 3: BMW M3 E92 GT2 – Spa Francorchamps
- 4: Ford Mustang GT3 – Sebring
- 5: Honda Civic R-GT500 – Suzuka circuit

- **“¿What happens if there're more participation than available?”**

That's an impossible case, the inscriptions are limited to the quantity we can carry on the championship organisation.

- **“¿How do I get inscribed?”**

In our website! There you will find all the necessary information and an intuitive way to get inscribed.

- **“¿What are the requirements?”**

There're 2; running Assetto Corsa in PC, and pay the inscription. We make it easy.

- **“¿What's the inscription price?”**

It's just 34,99 euros, only one time to race the whole championship; it's not price per race, the inscription is made for all the races of the championship.

- **“¿What are the itineraries?”**

We'll organise itineraries for the different time zones in the world so everyone that get inscribed is able to participate. The first round will have an extended duration, every day there will be one half an hour session in the morning, and one half an hour session in the evening/night; the participants will not have more than 2 consecutive days on this qualified sessions; we'll make a grouping procedure, as we already pointed out, the same group will not have to race for more than 2 consecutive days in this round. The following 4 rounds will be organised on “Race Weekend Format”, having all the day on Friday to complete a valid lap in the free practice session; on Saturday you will have qualification and first race, and for Sunday second and third races (one race weekend for each of this four rounds). For the sixth and final round the finalists of each time zone and the organisation will achieve an agreement to choose the itinerary for the final event.

- “¿When will the races be celebrated?”



- “¿What happens after getting inscribed?”  
We´ll send an invitation to our official championship channel on discord, where we´ll provide necessary instructions and materials to compete properly.
- “¿Is it a team competition?”  
We admit participants to unofficially take part of a team, but officially the scoring system is only made for independent drivers.
- “¿How many drivers do pass to second round?”  
Top 60% drivers!
- “¿Where do I get the mods?”  
We´ll provide them in our official discord channel where all the participants will receive an invitation.
- “¿Where do I get the car setup?”  
It will automatically apply when entering the official sessions, some times it may not be the standard setup, but anyway it works the same (automatically).
- “¿When will the inscription period get concluded?”  
When limited places get finished or with August finishing.
- “¿Do I get points for the championship in the first round too?”  
No, the points obtained in the first round will only affect for the eliminatory, to decide if you pass to the second round. Then for the race weekend format events the scoring system will be different.
- “¿Is professionalism required?”  
The inscriptions are completely open, we only require participants to follow a correct conduct in and out of the track.

- “¿What’s prizing system?”



- “¿Why is the inscription 50 euros price?”

We offer a high level organisation, a championship like this has never been celebrated and it requires a lot of work to make things happen properly. Apart from the amazing prize system we offer, distributing more than 20K Euros between the first 30 finishers.

- “¿Will the races be streamed?”

Yes, depending on the support we receive, we’ll stream and comment in Twitch and YouTube from only the final round to each of the Race Weekend events, as said the capacity to stream more or less races depends on the support we receive. The first round will be impossible to stream because there may be a lot of simultaneous sessions.

- “¿What duration will races have?”

In the first round there will be timed sessions of 30 minutes exclusively, one each weekday afternoon, and four on Saturdays, while Sundays will be taken as a rest day. (Qualifier format). In the following four rounds you will have a 10 hour free practice session on Friday where you have to complete at least one valid lap, on Saturday a 10 minutes qualifying and the first 30 minutes race, and on Sunday the second and third races of 30 minutes too. For the sixth and final round the finalists of each time zone and the organisation will achieve an agreement to choose the itinerary for the final event.

- “¿Can minors compete?”

Yes, we haven’t age restrictions, we only require participants to follow a correct conduct in and out of the track.

- “¿Does the mods for the championship have any extra cost?”

We require participants to install only 6 mods (Suzuka circuit, Zandvoort, Sebring, Honda Civic R-GT, Lotus Emira GT4, Ford Mustang GT3), three of them will be provided in the official discord channel where we'll invite all the participants, and for the other three of them we will provide you with a discount code and the link to get each of them for only 1 euro in collaboration with the developers of this mods.
